March 18, 2021

The regular meeting of the Stratford Irrigation District Board of Directors was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by President Charles Meyer. Other Directors present were B. Newton, M. Newton and T. Azevedo. Others present were Manager R. Silva, Secretary W. Areias, S. Jackson and C. Andrews. Directors absent S. Stanton.

A motion was made by Dir. T. Azevedo, seconded by Dir. B. Newton and carried to approve the minutes of the February 18, 2021 meeting.

Craig Andrews with Sandridge Partners reported that the Lateral 23 pipeline is finished. Craig Andrews asked the Board if Stratford ID would participate in the last 1/2 mile thru Dufur's and Orton's property.

The current financial report was presented by Treasurer W. Areias and included the following bills for payment:

A motion was made by Dir. M. Newton, seconded by Dir. B. Newton and carried to pay the bills as listed.

Copies of a Budget Update report for the period ending February 28, 2021 were distributed and reviewed by the Board.

Manager Silva reported that Pine Flat storage is 251,177 a/f; the natural flow is 547 c.f.s. SID storage is a total of approximately 8,000 a/f. Precipitation is 6.72 a/f. Snow pack is 43% of normal.

Director B. Newton reported on Lemoore Canal's March meeting, that the Annual Meeting was March 10<sup>th</sup> and the same directors were voted in.

Mr. Silva reported that KRWA had their Annual Meeting and they approved a budget of \$2,265,288. Stratford ID will pay approximately \$63,200 for the year in Water Right Fees and Pine Flat O & M. This is a 62% increase since 2017-2018 year.

Director M. Newton reported that the South Fork Kings Groundwater Sustainability Agency has a meeting tonight.

There was nothing new to report on SGMA.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 10:30 a.m.
