The Board of Equalization meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by President Charles Meyer. There being no objections heard, the meeting was adjourned.

The regular meeting of the Stratford Irrigation District Board of Directors was called to order at 10:03 a.m. by President Charles Meyer. Other Directors present were M. Newton, S. Stanton and T. Azevedo. Director Bill Newton absent. Others present were Manager R. Silva, Secretary W. Areias and C. Andrew.

A motion was made by Dir. S. Stanton, seconded by Dir. M. Newton and carried to approve the minutes of the August 19, 2021 meeting.

The current financial report was presented by Treasurer W. Areias and included the following bills for payment:

A motion was made by Dir. M. Newton, seconded by Dir. T. Azevedo and carried to pay the bills as listed.

Copies of a Budget Update report for the period ending August 31, 2021 were distributed and reviewed by the Board.

Manager Silva reported that Pine Flat storage is 199,775 a/f; total storage is 292,874 a/f. The natural flow is 104 c.f.s. SID storage is a total of approximately 4,300 a/f. There was 3,768 a/f of the Stratford ID-Lemoore Canal “A” water delivered and 1,082 a/f of Stratford ID’s River water. Stratford had 523 a/f left on the cards. Stratford ID also paid back Lemoore Canal the 821 a/f owed from a previous year.

Manager Silva reported at Lemoore Canal’s September meeting that if it is another dry year that Lemoore Canal may not run next year or if they do it will be no more that 15-20 days.

KRWA - Mr. Silva reported that there is nothing new to report. Meeting is next week.

Director M. Newton stated that there was nothing new to report concerning the South Fork Kings Groundwater Sustainability Agency. Mr. Silva received a phone call from Alex

Pytlak, he would like Stratford I.D. to provide how much water is delivered on individual parcels in its boundary.

A motion was made by Dir. M. Newton, seconded by Dir. S. Stanton and carried to levy an assessment of \$30.00 per acre for the 2021-2022 year.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 10:20 a.m.
