MANAGER'S REPORT - Manager Silva reported that Pine Flat storage is 611,589 a/f total storage is 843,775 a/f. The natural flow is 17,177 c.f.s. SID storage is a total of approximately 8,650 a/f. Precipitation is 174.8% of normal. The Flood Release will be going down to 10,600 cfs by this Sunday.

SOUTH FORK KINGS GROUNDWATER SUSTAINABILITY AGENCY - Dir. M. On June 21st the SWRCB will hold a hearing to determine a probationary hearing schedule for the six GSP's found to be inadequate.


OLD BUSINESS: There was no old business to report.
